## INSTRUCTIONS

We offer two separate recycling programs, one for **Yard Waste** and one for **Recycling**. You must sign up for each program in addition to your regular garbage service.

### Yard Waste

Yard Waste customers receive a 90 gallon container to be placed at the curb on collection day. Do not put plastic bags or other unacceptable items in the yard waste container.

**Acceptable:** Leaves, grass, weeds, shrubs and other compostable organic materials from pruning. Brush, branches, and roots cannot be larger than 4 inches in diameter and must fit into the container with the lid closed.

**Not Acceptable:** Stumps, demolition wood, rocks, glass, plastics, flower pots, metal, concrete, sheetrock, asphalt, or other non-organic debris. Also bones, food, manure, or large amounts of dirt will not be accepted.

(maximum weight 250#)

Extra yard waste should be placed next to your container in untied bags. A small additional fee will be charged for each extra.
