## Recycling

Recycling may reduce your overall garbage bill. Residential recycling in Pierce County is governed by the County's minimum service level ordinance and is a mandatory pay/voluntary subscription service. Businesses are strongly encouraged to recycle as a way to help the environment and reduce the amount of waste being sent to the landfill. There are a variety of recycling services available in your area, including options for recycling plastics, aluminum, paper, cardboard, metal, and wood.

Since glass products are excluded from the comingled recycling program, we have placed glass drop-off sites throughout the County for your convenience.

## Garbage Cart or Container Size

Selecting the correct size is important. A standard cart is 35-gallons. Container service is available for service needs ranging from 1 to 6 cubic yards. Keep in mind, overfilled or overweight carts or containers, additional bags, boxes, or carts larger than 35 gallons will cost extra. Be sure to select the right size container that meets your needs and give recycling a chance to work for you!

On March 1, 2019, the tipping fee in Pierce County increased by 4.42% or from \$157.38 per ton to \$164.34 per ton. This change is reflected in the rate and was calculated according to the requirements of the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission. Instead of sales tax on garbage service, the State of Washington charges a 3.6% Refuse Collection Tax.
