## Recycling

### 4 Easy Ways to reduce your overall disposal bill:

1. **Participate** in the Recycling Program to receive and remove the Recycling Incentive fee.
2. Learn **what** to recycle and encourage others to participate.
3. **Reduce and Reuse** to minimize what you are throwing away.
4. Evaluate your garbage **container size or collection frequency** for the most cost effective service.

Residential recycling in Pierce County is governed by the County's minimum service level ordinance and is a mandatory pay/voluntary subscription service. If you choose to participate in the recycling program, you will receive a lower overall bill. We provide curbside recycling and will pick up on a biweekly basis--the same days as your solid waste collection. It's easy and saves resources. We provide a 96-gallon wheeled recycling cart. Items accepted are conveniently listed on the lid for verification. On March 1, 2019, the tipping fee in Pierce County increased by 4.42% or from \$157.38 per ton to \$164.34 per ton. This change is reflected in the rate and was calculated according to the requirements of the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission. Instead of sales tax on garbage service, the State of Washington charges a 3.6% Refuse Collection Tax.

Since glass products are excluded from the comingled recycling program, we have placed glass drop-off sites throughout the County for your convenience.

Selecting the correct container size is important. Container service is available in most areas for service needs between 1 and 6 cubic yards. Keep in mind, overfilled or overweight containers, additional bags, boxes, etc. will cost extra. Please be sure your containers are accessible on your scheduled day(s) of service. Be sure to select the container size that meets your needs and give recycling a chance to work for you!

For disposal of large and bulky items like furniture and appliances, please contact our office to schedule a special pick-up.
